**Come and live the unique experience of 45 acres conceived for a Contemporary Art Garden. Up to a hundred sculptures erupt in a succession of gardens, swamp, woodland, lake, offering 2 or 3 hours of culture and relaxation for all ages.**



50 artists, French, Belgian, Polish, Swiss, Dutch and Canadian participate every year, even take up residence for several weeks in the 15th century Château, to erect their sometimes gigantic work.

Nanou and Piet Hendriks, Dutch farmers, acquired the Estate in the 90's, to fulfil their love of modern Art in fusion with the countryside. The four gardens have been designed by Countess Alix de Saint-Venant (Château Valmer in Vouvray) and by her brother Jacques Gérard. (arboretum La Fosse in Fontaine-Les-Coteaux)  
1400 roses, 1000 perennials, 5000 bulbs, ferns. Benches, the grass where you can also sit, refreshing tree shade, local produce sampling, kind welcome from the hosts. In brief... Paradise Found Again.
